PLEASE REVIEW THE INFORMATION REGARDING ADD-ON MONEY AT THE COUNTY SHOW SALE AND SIGN THE SIGNATURE LINE TO CONFIRM YOU HAVE READ THE INFORMATION.

For a family's student(s) to be eligible for add-on money at the county show sale, one of the following tiered system requirements must be met.

Tier 1 Requirements

The following requirements must be met to be eligible for the Tier 1, MINIMUM add-on contribution. The contribution amount will be up to 10% of the maximum contribution amount.

- Paid Wylie Ag Booster membership of \$30 and a completed membership form for the current membership year.
- Livestock entries registered under Wylie FFA and student(s) must have competed at the county show.
- Sell the required amount of raffle tickets per child to be eligible to receive funds.

Tier 2 Requirements

The following requirements must be met to be eligible for the Tier 2, MAXIMUM add-on contribution. The contribution amount will be determined by the Wylie Ag Booster Club executive board and will be based on funds available.

- Paid Wylie Ag Booster membership of \$30 and a completed membership form for the current membership year.
- Livestock entries registered under Wylie FFA and student(s) must have competed at the county show.
- Sell the required amount of raffle tickets per child to be eligible to receive funds.
- Complete one of the following three options:
 - Option #1 - Sell a VIP table or floor level table for Champions Bash.
 - Option #2 - Contribute a Live Auction item of value for Champions Bash. Item(s) value must be equivalent to the price of the lowest Champions Bash table available.
 - Option #3 – Volunteer at Wylie Ag Booster events. If completing this option, member must volunteer a total of 6 hours to fulfill requirement. Member must sign the attendance sheet at the event(s) and the time will be verified by a Wylie Ag Booster Club executive board member. Volunteer hours must be completed prior to the county livestock show to meet eligibility.

Examples of volunteer events may include the following:

1. The Wylie Local Livestock Show concession stand (January), the LDE Contest (*November), Feed the Band (*football/marching season) *(Not guaranteed to be an event option)
2. Attend Wylie Ag Booster meetings for the current "school year." Meetings count as 1 hour each. Only 2 meeting hours can count toward volunteer time. The remaining hours must be actual service hours worked.
3. Additional volunteer needs may arise at the request of our Ag Advisors.
